We will dispose of anything you have

except these prohibited items:

- No roofing or construction rubble
- No gas, oil or engines containing these
 - No paint, chemicals or solvents
 - No computer monitors
 - No hazardous or liquid waste
- Call the St. Joe County Waste Management District at 574 235-9971 for information on disposal of any of the above.

Latex paint - add Kitty Litter to the can and allow to dry then discard in normal trash.

Tires - \$1 each to cover the disposal fee would be appreciated.

Refrigerators and freezers - will be accepted this year.
